



BASICS Doctor Pre-Hospital Care - Annual Review

Background

As a doctor registered with the General Medical Council we are required to undertake annual appraisal which will inform the 5 yearly revalidation cycle.

The following guidance has been issued for Appraisals for 2015 *“Your NHS appraisal **must** cover the whole scope of your medical practice, for example, if you are a GPwSI in dermatology, an appraiser, hold a managerial position with the CCG, or work as a doctor to a local racecourse. You **must have a review by your manager/director in this role.**”*

The following process has been developed to support BASICS Doctors with their Annual Appraisal, it also provides SWASFT with assurance that it’s pool of BASICS doctors are current and safe. It also fulfills the requirements of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that has been developed between SWASFT and BASICS South West.



The annual review form should be completed electronically and returned to Katherine Lunk (Community Engagement team). The BASICS south West committee along with the Community Engagement Manger (Rob Horton) and the Executive Medical Director will peer review each form. The overarching aim is for this to be a constructive and helpful process that will both inform your appraisal and your PDP.

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
